

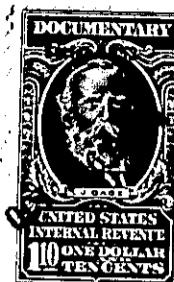

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

LILLIAN H. MOSELEY, her Heirs and Assigns forever;

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 2 of Peter White lands according to plat made by Dalton & Neves, December, 1946, located on an alley running West from Alice Avenue, to-wit:

"BEGINNING on South side of said alley 232.6 feet West of Alice Avenue at corner of Lot 3; thence with Lot 3, S. 14-37 E, 125.8 feet to George Williams line; thence with Williams line S. 77-27 W. 50 feet to Frank McKinney's corner; thence with McKinney's line N. 14-37 W. 125 feet to said alley; thence with alley N. 76-12 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner."

Being the same property conveyed to Ida Mae Blassingame by deed recorded in Deed Book 305 at Page 190; the said Ida Mae Blassingame died in testate on June 20, 1951 leaving as her only heirs, her husband, W. C. Blassingame, and five children, Elliott Blassingame, Horace Blassingame, Josephine Blassingame, Janie B. Walker, and Margie B. Griffin, the grantors herein. One other child was born to the said Ida Mae Blassingame, Norman O. Blassingame, who died in 1945 leaving no children and his wife died subsequently.
