KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That George Parr, Jr., of the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of one hundred, fifty Dollars to George Parr, Jr. in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by George Parr, Jr. (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said George Parr, Jr.

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina

containing one mile north of Chick Springs and lying east of Lot No. 14 and being known and designated as Lot No. 14 and being adjacent to each other of a subdivision of the W. A. Seybt property, and having in the aggregate the following metes and bounds according to plot and survey by H. L. Sanchez, S. E., Jan. 21, 1917, a plat of which is recorded in the S. E. C. office for Greenville County in Book 328 Page 121:

to-wit: the first line (the line that divides lot no. 13) is not in the plot the lot no. 13 being shown as whole on plot.

beginning at a stake on the south side of a county road at point which is the middle of Lot No. 13 and running thence S. 29-40 W. 150 feet to a stake corner to be in middle of Lot No. 13, thence running with lines of lot nos. 42 and 41 N. 65-30 E. 75 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 15 and running thence with line of lot No. 15 in a northeasterly direction 150 feet to a stake on the south side of a county road; and thence with said county road S. 62-48 W. 75 feet to the beginning corner.
