QUITCLAIM DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, in order to remove any cloud from the title, which may now or hereafter arise or exist, and in consideration of the sum of One and No/100ths (\$1.00) Dollars to the grantor in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), I, Lillie Maude Hudson Greene, have granted, bargained, sold and quitclaimed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and quitclaim unto the said

Lillie Maude Greene, her heirs and assigns,

Any and all right, title and interest of the grantor in and to that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Southern side of the Old Spartanburg Road about five miles from the City of Greenville, containing one-half (1/2) acre, more or less,
