- e. Deed to the Spartanburg Radiocasting Company, a corporation, from W.H. Corbetton W. A. Corbett, being lots Nos. 8,9,10, 17 and 18, all being in Block M, as shown on plat of Subdivision known as Blue Ridge Forest, made by E.S.Draper, Architect and Engineer, April 1926.
