Dear Mr. Farnsworth:

On September 22, 1955, there was filed in your office Federal tax lien No. 55-1294 against Charlie Douglas Lockhart. It now appears that this notice of lien erroneously listed Spartanburg County as the county for filing whereas it was intended that said notice of lien should read Greenville County. Of course, this office could issue a new instrument, but rather than show two notices of liens outstanding against the same taxpayer, we would prefer to change the erroneous Spartanburg designation to read Greenville. In this connection we are asking our Group Supervisor in Greenville, Mr. G. W. Hayes, to present this letter to you and be allowed the privilege of drawing a line through Spartanburg County, Spartanburg, South Carolina, appearing on the lien and inserting Greenville County, Greenville, South Carolina and then all of the records with respect to this notice of lien would be correct.

As you know the lien of the United States arises at the time the assessment is made and not when the Notice of Lien is filed. The purpose of our filing the notice of lien is merely to give notice to certain creditors that there exists a lien in favor of the United States against the taxpayer.

Thank you for your consideration in this matter.
