all that piece, parcel, or lot of land, in Greenville County, South Carolina, on the
northern side of Florida Avenue, and on the eastern side of Lynhurst Drive, known
as lot no. 173 of section 11 of Oak-Crest, as shown by plat or corner, made by
J. C. Jones, Engineer, recorded in the Greenville County office in Plat
Book "A" at pages 130 and 131, and having, according to said plat, the following
limits and bound:

Beginning at a point on the eastern side of Lynhurst Drive, joint right corner of lots
172 and 173, and running thence with the eastern side of Lynhurst Drive S. 25-4
E. 5 feet to a pin; thence with the curve of the intersection of Lynhurst Drive and
Florida Avenue, the tangent thereof being S. 57-14 E. 37-4 W.; thence along the
southern side of Florida Avenue; thence with the northern line of Florida Avenue
S. 57-14 E. 125 feet to a pin at the rear corner of lot 173 and 174; thence with the
line of lot 174 S. 22-06 E. 111.6 feet to a pin at the rear corner of lot 172;
thence with the line of lot 172 S. 57-24 E. 154.6 to the beginning corner.
