All that lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about 2 1/2 miles West of the City of Greenville, on the Western side of Hunt Street, and according to plat of property of C. P. Brumley, made by R. E. Dalton in February 1946, is described as follows:
