TO: Honorable J. P. Ashmore, Supervisor for Greenville County, and to the County Board of Commissioners for Greenville County, South Carolina.

Your petitioner, William R. Timmons, Jr., is the owner of a certain tract of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the South side of the newly constructed by-pass between the Old Camp Road (at Shriners' Hospital), to the New Buncombe Road (at Stone Manufacturing Company); said property being shown as lots # 112 through 130, on a plat of Piney Mountain Park, made by Brodie and Bedell, on August 30, 1913, recorded in Plat Book E at Page 201.

That as shown on said plat a street or road known as Claremont
Drive was laid out and opened through the said lots, but that the newly
constructed by-pass intersects said Claremont Drive at two points so that
it is now merely a loop or circle which begins at the by-pass, leads south
then turns at an angle or loop to the north, and again intersects the by-pass.
There are no intersecting roads or side-roads on this segment of Claremont
Drive, and your petitioner owns all of the property fronting on both
sides of this segment of Claremont Drive; therefore, this portion of
Claremont Drive does not and cannot serve any property other than the
property owned by your petitioner and is not a part of the county roads,
as this area is adequately served by the by-pass.

That this segment of Claremont Drive, since the construction of the new by-pass, is not only of no value to the petitioner or to the County or to anyone else, but is detrimental to the use of the petitioner's property and should be discontinued, abandoned and closed.
