

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That REEVES BROTHERS, INCORPORATED, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of South Carolina, Grantor, in consideration of \$1.00 to it in hand paid by DUKE POWER COMPANY, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and of the agreement on the part of Duke Power Company to be performed as hereinafter set out, does hereby grant unto said Duke Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and easement to go in and upon that certain tract of land in Greenville County, South Carolina, in or near the City of Greenville, lying on Brushy Creek, being the Mills Mill #1 Greenville Division plant of Grantor, and being shown on print File No. 15-135 dated May 2, 1956, hereto attached and made a part hereof, and to construct, maintain and operate in, upon and through said premises in a proper manner with poles, wires, guys and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line for transmitting and distributing power by electricity and for telephone purposes; together with the right at all times to enter said premises for the purpose of inspecting said line and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right at all times to cut away and keep clear of said line for a distance of 20 feet on each side of the center line of same all trees, structures and other obstructions that may in any way endanger or interfere with the proper maintenance and operation of the same, with the right to cut away any trees outside of said 20-foot distance which if they should fall or be cut or blown down might strike said line.

The center line of the right of way hereby granted extends from pole No. 11 (P-11) to station 6/09.5, to pole No. 14 (P-14) as shown by red line on the attached print and thereon indicated "Relocation".

By accepting this instrument Duke Power Company agrees to remove its present line from the premises of Grantor, which line is shown by green
