in consideration of the sum of Twelve Hundred Forty-Four & 14/100 (\$1244.14) - - - DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Edith M. Johnston, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 75 according to the plat of College Heights, made by Dalton and Neves, dated August 1946, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book P at Page 75, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northwestern side of Erskine Street at the joint front corner of lots Nos. 75 and 76, which iron pin is situate 46.2 feet northeast of the intersection of a 20 foot road and Erskine Street, and situate 380 feet southwest of the intersection of Erskine Street and Griffin Drive, and running thence along the line of Lot No. 76 N. 33-10 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence along the lines of lots Nos. 66 and 67 N. 56-50 E. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of lot No. 74 S. 33-10 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the northwestern side of Erskine Street, joint front corner of lots Nos. 74 and 75; thence with the northwestern side of Erskine Street S. 56-50 W. 70 feet to the point of beginning.

The grantee assumes and agrees to pay that certain note and mortgage to C. Douglas Wilson and Company, recorded in Mortgage Book 595 at Page 409, in the sum of \$10,405.86.

Being the same property conveyed to the grantor in Deed Book 499 at Page 318.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

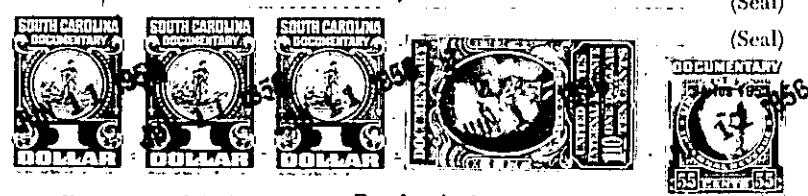
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and her Heirs and Assigns forever.
