

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said M. G. Proffitt

All that piece, parcel or lot of land with the improvements thereon in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the southeast side of Mount Vista Avenue, being shown and designated as Lot No. 177 of Plat of Traxler Park, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "F" at Page 114, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the southeast side of Mount Vista Avenue at corner of Lot No. 176, and running thence with the southeast side of Mount Vista Avenue, N. 64-37 E. 70 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 178; thence with the line of Lot No. 178, S. 25-33 E. 225 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 223; thence with the line of Lot No. 223, S. 64-37 W. 70 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 176; thence with the line of Lot No. 176, N. 25--23 W. 225 feet to a stake on Mount Vista Avenue, the point of beginning.

This is the identical property conveyed to A. C. Crouch et al, as Trustees of Westminster Presbyterian Church of Greenville, by J. Louis Coward by his deed dated January 20, 1948, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 334 at Page 19.

This conveyance is made subject to restrictive covenants applicable to Traxler Park, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 327 at Page 91.

This conveyance is made pursuant to a resolution of the congregation of Westminster Presbyterian Church of Greenville authorizing and directing the same, duly adopted at a congregational meeting held after notice stating the purpose thereof, on October 14, 1956.
