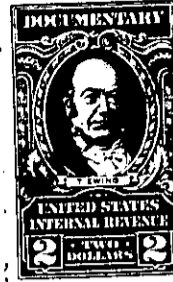
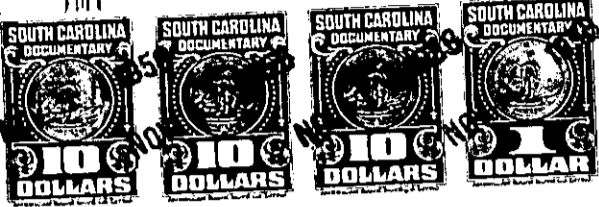

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Cecil G. White, Jr.,
and Virginia C. White, their heirs and assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chicks Springs Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as a two (2) acre
tract located on Paris Mountain and being shown on a survey made by
C. O. Riddle, May 5, 1953, of the property of E. D. Harrell, Jr. and
L. G. Causey and having, according to said plat, the following metes
and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Altamont Road at corner of property owned
by the grantors and running thence N. 85-30 E. 228 feet to an iron pin;
thence running S. 11-00 E. 328.7 feet to a branch in line; thence
running N. 82-14 W. 64 feet to an iron pin in spring; thence running
S. 85-43 W. 234.4 feet to an iron pin on Altamont Road; thence running
along Altamont Road, N. 15-57 W. 96.4 feet to an iron pin; thence
running N. 0-03 E. 97.3 feet; thence running N. 17-09 E. 119.3 feet
