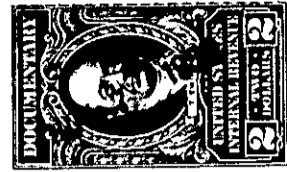

in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

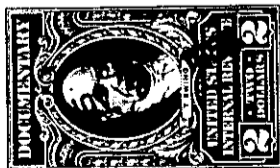
WHEREAS, The City of Greenville, S. C., a municipal corpo-
