to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Frank Hall, his heirs and assigns:

All that piece; parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot Sixteen (16) on plat of Carver Court made by Piedmont Engineering Service, March, 1955, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book I I, page 107, and having according to said plat the following courses and distances, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Elder Street, joint front corner of Lot 16 and 17 and running thence along the line of Lot No. 17 S. 37-05 E. 150.0 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 52-31 E. 70 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot No. 15; thence along the line of Lot No. 15 N. 37-05 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on Elder Street; thence along Elder Street S. 52-58 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner.

The lot above described is conveyed subject to the covenants and restrictions recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 523, page 297, which are made a part hereof as fully as if set out herein, and to the public utility easement granted to the Duke Power Company, dated September 1, 1953, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 533, page 234.

The lot herein conveyed constitutes a portion of the property conveyed to us by Jessie D. Webster by deed dated September 20, 1954, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 509, page 122.

State and County taxes for the year 1956 are to be paid by the grantee.
