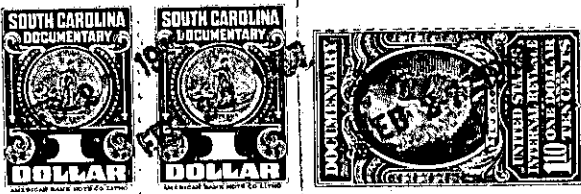

C., constituting and being the Board of Deacons of said Fairview Street Baptist Church of Fountain Inn, S. C., their Successors in office, forever:

ALL that lot of land situate on the Southeast side of Fairview Street, in the Town of Fountain Inn, in Greenville County, S. C., and having, according to a plat made by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated December, 1955, the following metes and bounds, to wit:
