The section of road herein transferred is shown on a plat made by Piedmont Engineering Service, June 27, 1947, as running in a Northeasterly direction from the property now owned by Young, a winding course to the line of property now or formerly owned by Marchbanks, and lying North of Bald Rock and property of Batson and S. C. Highway Department.
