Tarrant, as Trustee, on the 4th day of March, 1957. The said Assignees covenant to perform the terms and conditions of the said Assignor relative to said Timber Contract; and the Assignor covenants that all timber on said 107 acre tract, whether standing or cut, is a part of, and included in this assignment, said Timber Contract hereto attached containing the the terms and conditions as to size and stumpage.

This assignment of the attached Timber Contract includes all both of that tract of land lying on sides of the Pelzer Road, known as the Old Garrison Home Place, and containing 107 acres, according to a plat made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, January 15, 1934, LESS HOWEVER, two lots in Tarrant Heights heretofore conveyed to Margaret S. Kelly et al by W. E. Tarrant, as Trustee; said deed being recorded in The R.M.C.
