on both sides of Campbells' Mill creek, beginning at a stone at the edge of creek bottom on Sallie Hensons line and runs thence N. 73.51 W. 9.53 chs. to a stake on the Flemming Henson estate line, thence, S. 16 1/2 W. 14.72 chs. to a stone, thence S. 62 1/2 E. 9.69 chs. to a stone thence, S. 9 1/2 E. 7.82 chs. to a stone (Persimmon cone) thence, N. 44 E. - 10.32 chs. to a stone, thence N. 29 W. 5.72 chs to a stone, thence N. 8 1/2 E. 4.40 chs to a stone, thence N. 77 W. 2.60 chs to a stone, thence, N. 25 1/2 E. 2.50 chs to a stone, thence, N. 1 W. 3.65 chs to the beginning corner, and contains Twenty Three and one half (23 1/2) acres more or less which is one half of the whole (See Plat book A page 527 R.
