NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Preesents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said John L. Ashmore, his heirs and assigns:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. "B"
of North Hills, according to plat of said property made by Dalton &
Neves, Engineers, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County
in plat book H, page 90, and having a frontage on the south side of
Russell Avenue of 50 feet, said lot containing brick veneer bungalow.

BEING the same property conveyed to Emma L. North by W. B. Mulligan
by deed dated November 6, 1943 and of record in the R. M. C. Office
for Greenville County in Deed Book 258 at page 103.

The consideration for this conveyance is \$3,000.00 and this deed is
executed in pursuance to the Decree of Court in the case of Gladys
