HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said George W. Webb
All that piece, parcel and lot of land lying and being about 1/2 mile southward from the Town of Simpsonville on the eastern side of the Laurens Road in Fairview Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, with a residence located thereon and containing 2.66 acres, more or less, and being all that remains of a larger tract of land conveyed to I. W. Cook by Fred H. Pollard and Pallie S. Pollard by deed dated November 3, 1944, recorded in Deed Book 269, Page 16. The land is the same as was conveyed to J. E. Kestler by I. W. Cook and Elizabeth S. Cook by deed dated April 16, 1954, recorded in Deed Book 498, Page 35.
