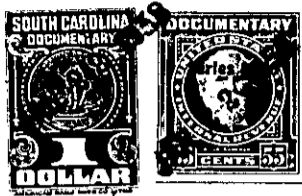

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, GREENVILLE

County, State of South Carolina being known ~~as~~ and designated as the northwest half of Lot 113 "Conestee Plat 2", made by Madison H. Woodward, Engineer, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book T at pages 383-384, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of West Pine Lake Circle at the joint corner of Lots 112 and 113 and running thence ~~thence~~ along the joint line of said Lots S. 72-06 E. 218.8 feet to an iron pin; thence through Lot 113 to an iron pin on Lot 114; running thence along the line of Lot 114 N. 72-06 W. 215.9 to an iron pin on the Southeast side of West Pine Lake Circle; running thence along said street S. 20-13 W. 70.5 feet to an iron pin; point of beginning.
