Highway No. 291), at the intersection of said street with an unnamed street; thence along a curve, the chord of which is N. 15-03 W. 26.4 feet to an iron pin on the southwest side of said unnamed street; thence continuing along said unnamed street, N. 56-17 W. 209.5 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running S. 26-11 W. 89.5 feet to a point; thence turning and running S. 63-49 E. 225 feet to a point on the northwest side of Pleasantburg Drive; thence along Pleasantburg Drive, N. 26-11 E. 42.5 feet to the point of beginning.
