- 8. A Trustee shall have the right to resign by instrument in writing, the original to be attached to this instrument and a copy thereof to be mailed by registered mail to each of the Beneficiaries at his or her last known address.
- 9. Should the Trustees named in this instrument or either of them resign for any reason whatsoever or should the demise of a Trustee occur prior to the time designated in this instrument for the termination and distribution of the corpus of the Trust Estate, then in that event a successor Trustee shall be appointed by the written concurrence of three-fourths (3/4ths) of the Beneficiaries in interest, and should the said Beneficiaries fail to concur as aforesaid in the selection of a successor Trustee, then in that event the successor Trustee shall be appointed in an exparte proceeding in the Greenville County Court upon petition of any one of the Beneficiaries of this trust. Such successor Trustee thereupon shall be vested with all the powers and duties granted to and imposed upon the Trustee herein named.
 - 10. This agreement may be amended and modified from time to time by instrument in writing to be attached to this instrument and copies thereof to be delivered to the Trustees signed by three-fourths (3/4ths) of the Beneficiaries in interest, and provided further that the duties, powers, and liabilities of the Trustees shall not be materially or substantially changed by any such amendment or modification without his consent thereto in writing.
 - ll. This trust may be terminated at any time by an instrument in writing attached to this instrument and copies thereof delivered to the Trustees signed by three-fourths (3/4ths) of the Beneficiaries in interest, and provided further that this trust shall terminate in any event at the end of twenty (20) years from and after the death of the last survivor of all of the Beneficiaries named in this instrument. Immediately upon the termination of this
