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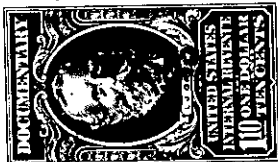

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in _____ Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

in the City of Greenville, on the Southern side of Ackley Street, being shown as Lot No. 1 on Plat of property of William Hall Estate made by Piedmont Engineering Service on May 15, 1952, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Southern side of Ackley Street, at the corner of other property of the Grantee, and running thence with the line of said property, S. 7-22 E. 279.2 feet to a stake; thence S. 70-45 W. 57 feet to a stake at the corner of Lot No. 2; thence with the line of said lot, N. 7-00 W. 272 feet to a stake on Ackley Street; thence with the Southern side of said Road, N. 63-36 E. 57 feet to the beginning corner.

Being a portion of the property conveyed to Adam Hall by Deeds recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 458, at page 274, Deed Book 490, at page 494 and Deed Book 458, at page 273; the said Adam Hall died intestate on April 7, 1957, leaving as his only heirs his wife, Beatrice C.
