J. M. Clodfelter and James D. Cordell, their heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on the Southern side of West Parker Road, designated as Lot # 11, Block C, of Hughes Heights Subdivision, as shown on a plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "GG" at pages 122-123, and having according thereto the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a concrete monument on the Southern side of West Parker Road at the joint front corner of Lots # 10 and 11, and running thence S: 26-26 W. 225.4 feet to an iron pin on a service drive; thence along said service drive N. 56-30 W. 77.6 feet to a concrete monument; thence along the line of Lot # 12 N. 26-26 E. 215.8 feet to an iron pin; thence along the Southern side of West Parker Road S. 63-34 E. 77 feet to the point of beginning.

The above described property is subject to restrictions applicable to Hughes Heights Subdivision, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 526 at page 462. The subject premises constitute a portion of the real estate owned by T.T. Hughes at the time of his death. The said T.T. Hughes died testate on July 24, 1951, his Will being of record in the office of the Probate Court for Greenville County in Apt. 603, File 10.
