- 1. With respect to these lots, the use of the property for normal pasture, grazing and agricultural purposes shall not be considered business use.
- 2. With respect to these lots the restrictions against the presence of animals other than domestic pets is hereby amended to the extent that use of the property as a pasture shall not be prohibited. This amendment shall not allow anyone to stall or quarter, in close confinement, animals upon the property, but is merely intended to allow use of the property as a grazing area.

These amendments shall also apply to the portions of the two streets reserved for private use.
