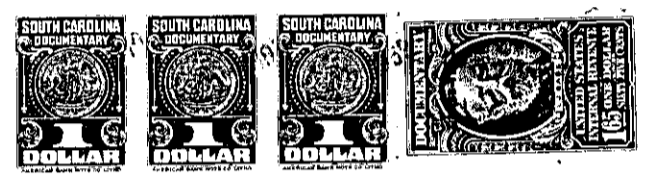

Office for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ, Page 11, and according to said plat having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
