ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, North of the Town of Travelers Rest, on the East side of the Geer Highway, being delineated on a plat of property prepared for the R.L. Duncan Estate and Mrs. Georgia Duncan, by Terry T. Dill, Surveyor, September, 1948, recorded in Plat Book Vol. OO at page 347, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
