do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Ethel Rogers Justus, for and during
 the term of her natural life only, and upon her death, to her children
 then surviving her. In case any of her children, heirs of her body, should
 predecease her leaving children, then the share which their parent would
 have taken is to be divided equally among such children of a deceased child.

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda township,
 Greenville County, State of South Carolina and containing one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$)
 acre, more or less, on the west side of the Hendersonville and Greenville
 Highway and on the south side of the road leading from the said Hender-
 sonville and Greenville Highway to Marietta, South Carolina, adjoining
