"All that certain part and parcel of land, lying and situate in six miles of Greer, S. C. in O'Neal Township, lying north side of Bruce Road, being bounded on North by Beaver Dam Creek, and lands of Dean Bruce, on the East by the remainder of the 10 acre tract which C. L.
