

George L. Irwin and Cecile H. Irwin, their heirs and assigns:

75 mg ALL that piece, parcel, or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 76, Section 1, Lake Forest, a plat of which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book GG, Page 17, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwestern side of Lake Fairfield Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 76 and 77, and running along the joint line of said lots, N 38-43 W 176.3 feet to an iron pin in the joint rear corner of said lots; thence S 59-09 W 83.9 feet to an iron pin in the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 75 and 76; thence along the joint line of said lots, S 29-25 E 191 feet to an iron pin in the joint front corner of said lots in the northwestern side of Lake Fairfield Drive; thence along the northwestern side of Lake Fairfield Drive, N 51-41 E 110 feet to the point of beginning.

of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty.


