

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto JOHN L. PLYLER, ERNEST PATTON and ELDREDGE M. CASKEY, as Trustees of The Furman University Foundation under Trust Indenture, dated February 25, 1948, its successors and assigns, forever:

ALL that lot of land situate on the Northwest side of Wade Hampton Boulevard (U.S. Highway No.29), near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, and is designated as Lot No.5 on a plat made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in 1938, and having, according to said plat and a survey made by Piedmont Engineering Service, December 17, 1953, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwest side of Wade Hampton Boulevard, said point being where the Northwest side of Wade Hampton Boulevard intersects with the Southwest side of a 36 foot unnamed street and running thence along the Southwest side of said unnamed street, N. 47-00 W., 325 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 43-00 W., 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 47-00 E., 325 feet to an iron pin on the Northwest side of Wade Hampton Boulevard; thence along the Northwest side of Wade Hampton Boulevard, N. 43-00 E., 150 feet to the beginning corner.
