C. in Plat Book Y, page 21, together with the Directors of the said The Greenville Motor Boat Club, Inc., as liquidating trustees of said corporation have concluded that restrictions No. 2, 3 and 6, as recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 410, page 151, prevented the owner of a lot from placing a valid mortgage on the premises and have agreed that these said restrictions should be
