

LEE POOLE and RUTH S. POOLE (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. LEE POOLE and RUTH S. POOLE, all the following described property, to-wit:-

The eastern one-half (1/2) of Lot No. 100 of Springwood Cemetery, said one-half of Lot No. 100 hereby conveyed measuring 11 ft. by 8 ft., and being part of the same property conveyed to G. W. Griffin on November 27, 1918, by deed recorded in Deed Book 6 at Page 619, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, for the right of burial and cemetery purposes, and to be used exclusively for the right and purpose aforesaid, and subject to the conditions of the Charter of said grantor, and all revisions thereof and amendments that may be made thereto, and also subject to the Ordinances of said City and the rules, regulations and by-laws of the City Council and Cemetery Trustees or Committee, now in force, or which may hereafter be passed, relating to said cemetery and the burial of the dead therein, which property was devised to us under the Will of the said G. W. Griffin.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the said J. LEE POOLE and RUTH S. POOLE, their Heirs and Assigns forever.

And we do hereby bind ourselves, our Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said J. LEE POOLE and RUTH S. POOLE, their Heirs and Assigns against us and our Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
