All those lots of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the southwest side of Laurens Road, in the City of Greenville, being shown as lots # 10 and 11 on a plat of the property of E. G. Webster, recorded in Plat Book K at Page 39, and according to a plat made by Dalton & Neves in June 1960, are described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwest side of Laurens Road, 65.4 feet northwest from Greenacre Road, at corner of lot # 9, and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 34-30 W. 166.6 feet to iron pin in the line of lot # 8; thence N. 55-44 W. 140 feet to iron pin, corner of lot # 12; thence with the line of said lot, N. 34-30 E. 166.6 feet to iron pin on Laurens Road; thence with the southwest side of said Road, S. 55-44 E. 140 feet to the beginning corner.

Being the same property conveyed to the grantor by deed recorded in Book of Deeds 393 at Page 217.
