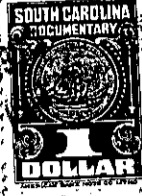

County, State of South Carolina, and being more particularly described as Lot 46,  
Section A as shown on a plat entitled "A" Subdivision for Woodside Mills,  
Greenville, South Carolina.", made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers,  
Greenville, South Carolina January 14, 1950 and recorded in the RMC Office
