County, State of South Carolina, about Five (5) miles from the City of Green-ville, on new State Highway leading from Greenville to Laurens, and, according to a plat of survey made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, 1945, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:  BEGINNING ON A stake on the southern edge of the right of way of the Laurens Road (a State Highway), and running thence S.37-22 W. 752 feet to a stake in the old Laurens Road; thence with the said old Road, S. 58-38 E. 200 feetto a bend in said old Road; thence S. 56-33 E. 140 feet to a stake in the said old Road; thence N. 37-34 E. 656 feet to a stake on the southern edge of the right of way of the said new Laurens Road; thence with the southern edge of the new Laurens Highway right of way, N. 42-43 W. 340 feet to the beginning corner; and containing Five and 43/100 (5.43) Acres, more or less, and being a part of a tract of Sixty Two (62) acres of land, more or less, conveyed to William H.
