CHARTER

EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT

BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

OLLE HUGUENIN and JOHN T. DOUGLAS

T. F. HUGUENIN and JOHN T. DOUGLAS

both of

Greenville, S. C.

did on the 23rd day of September, 1960, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is HUGUENIN-DOUGLAS CO.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA

4th. That the general nature of the business which it proposes to do is conduct a general insurance agency dealing in and with all types of insurance, to act as local or general agent for all types of insurance companies in the conduct of a general insurance business, including the solicitation and receipt of applications for all types of insurance, and the collection of premiums and the other duties necessary, incidental or useful for insurance agencies, or as delegated to it as agent for or by insurance companies; to conduct an insurance brokerage business; to investigate, examine, appraise, adjust and audit claims and losses arising under policies of insurance issued by companies for which it is agent; to conduct for itself or as agents or correspondents for others a general real estate and rental business, and general brokerage business, with power to purchase, acquire, hold, own, sell, convey, lease, mortgage, encumber, manage, improve and generally deal in and with real and personal property of all kinds, and the construction and selling of houses and buildings, to act as agent or broker therefor and to pay and collect commissions on any such transactions, and for itself or as agent or correspondent for others, to buy, sell, own, trade and generally deal in stocks, bonds, commercial papers, mortgages, on all types of property and other securities, and for itself and as agent or correspondent to deal in and with surety bonds; to acquire the good will, assets and liabilities of any person, firm, association, or corporation, and generally to do any and all things necessary, incidental or useful therefor and all things and acts which a corporation may do under the laws of the State of South Carolina.
