One-half (1/2) interest in all that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, being located on Crescent Ave. and having the following lines and courses, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Crescent Ave.; at the intersection of McDaniel Ave. and running thence along McDaniel Ave. N. 5-27 E. 194.1 feet to an iron pin; thence along line property now or formerly owned by J.A. McDaniel S. 84 -37 W. 115.9 feet to an iron pin, joint corners with lot #6; thence along lines of lot No. 6; S. 1-00 W. 193.1 feet to an iron pin on Crescent Ave.; thence along said Crescent Ave.; N. 83-52 E. 100.7 feet to the beginning corner and being known and designated as lot No. 7; according to a Plat of a part of the J.A.
