All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the southerly side of Echols Drive, near the City of Greenville, S.C., being shown as Lot No. 28 on the plat of property of Elizabeth E. Voyles, as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book Y, page 73, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southerly side of Echols Drive at a point 289.2 feet east of the southeasterly corner of the intersection of Echols Drive and Augusta Road, said pin being the joint front corner of Lots 28 and 29, and running thence along the southerly side of Echols Drive N 68-18 E 90 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots 27 and 28; thence with the joint line of Lots 27 and 28, S 21-42 E 111.4 feet to an iron pin; thence S 68-18 W 90 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 28 and 29; thence with the joint line of said Lots N 21-42 W 111.4 feet to the point of beginning.
