The easement right of way granted and random encroachments of the said wall affect the following described property:

"Beginning at an iron pipe at the N.W. corner of the Annie I. Huguenin, Henry F. Ross and J. Henry Sittons' property and the S. W. corner of the R. M. Caine property, said corner being N. 20 deg. 47 ft. E. 150.6 feet from the intersection of the north right-of-way line of East McBee Avenue and the east right-of-way line of South Brown Street and located on the east right-of-way line of South Brown Street; thence with the south boundary line of the R. M. Caine property, S. 69 deg. 39 ft. E. 102 feet to a point; thence N. 20 deg. 47 ft. E. 0.8 feet to a point; then N. 69 deg. 39 ft. W. to a point on the west boundary line of the R. M.
