In addition to the restrictive covenants imposed on all of the lots in the above described subdivision by instrument dated January 9, 1960, recorded in Deed Book 643 at Page 135 in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and without altering or changing said restrictions other than by imposing an additional restriction, the following restriction is imposed upon Lots Nos. 53, 54, 55, 56, 57, 59, 60, 61, 66, 80, 81, 82, 84 and 85.

No dwelling shall be permitted on any of these lots at a cost of less than \$25,000.00 based upon cost levels prevailing on the date these covenants are recorded, it being the intention and purpose of this covenant to assure that all dwellings shall be of a quality of workmanship and materials substantially the same or better than that which can be produced on the date this covenant is recorded at the minimum cost stated herein for the minimum permitted dwelling size.

This covenant is for the benefit of the lots specifically enumerated herein and may be enforced by the owners of any of the said lots, but not by the owners of any other lots in the subdivision, and shall be binding upon the Colonial Mortgage and Realty Company, its successors and assigns, purchasers and transferees until January 1, 1990.
