"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, being known and designated as a portion of Lot No. 6 according to a plat of property of John Colageras, being a subdivision of Lots Nos. 14 through 27 of Verner Heights, which plat was prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, June 27, 1925 and recorded in the R.
