C: O. Allen died testate in Greenville County, S. C., on March 28, 1932, leaving his last will and testament dated January 12, 1932, which was duly entered for probate. See Apartment 287, File 5, Office of the Judge of Probate for Greenville County. The property hereinabove described passed under the residuary clause of said will, being Item V thereof, to be held in trust for his wife, Nannie Jeffries Allen, for her life and thereafter to remain in trust but within time to eventually pass to his children, elsewhere in his will named as Ramath Allen Humphreys, Virginia Allen Potter, Elizabeth Allen Askins and Walter H. Allen. Item V further provided that the child or children of a deceased child would take the parent's share.
