

TRACT NO. 1. All that certain tract or parcel of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina and in Glassy Mt. Township. Beginning on south side of Glassy Mt. Road at a stone and running thence N. 88 1/4 E. 1.75 chains to a stone on the North side of said road; thence N. 8-35 E. 18.33 chains to a stone; thence N. 76 1/4 E. 2.45 chains to a white oak stump on Evans Line; thence N. 24 3/4 W. 9.25 chains to a stone on Evans Line; thence S. 30 1/2 E. 10.25 chains to a stone on C. S. West Line; thence S. 6-55 E. 18.54 chains to the beginning corner and containing twelve (12) acres, more or less. Bounded now or formerly by lands of D. R. Evans, C. S. West and others, and known as a part of the L. P. Barnett place and being the same property conveyed to J. T. Turner by deed of C. S. West recorded in Deed Book 109, Page 551, R.M.C.
