(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lawrence E. Hudson, his heirs and assigns

ALL that certain parcel or lot of land situated on the south side of Endless Drive and the east side of Dogwood Avenue, about two miles northward from the City of Greer, Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, and being a portion of Lot No. 5 of the property of W. Dennis Smith, according to survey and plat by H. S. Brockman, Registered Surveyor, recorded in Plat Book NN, page 168, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the intersection of Dogwood Avenue and Endless Drive, and running thence along said Drive, N. 88-00 E. 129 feet to an iron pin, new corner; thence a new line through original Lot No. 5, S. 0-10 E. 165.3 feet to an iron pin on line of Lot No. 4; thence along the line of Lot No. 4, S. 88-00 W. 129 feet to an iron pin on Dogwood Avenue; thence along said Avenue, N. 0-10 W. 165.3 feet to the beginning corner.
