Harding, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, and being shown as Lot No. 36 on Plat of Western Hills, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ at Pages 98-9, and having, according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northerly side of Tucson Drive, at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 36 and 37, and running thence with the common line of said Lots, N. 0-15 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 89-45 E. 90 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 0-15 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the northerly side of Tucson Drive; thence with said Drive, N. 89-45 W. 90 feet to the point of beginning.

The above lot is conveyed subject to the recorded restrictions applicable to Western Hills and to the easements and rights-of-way, if any, and the setback line as shown on said Plat.
