All that lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Paris Mountain Township, containing 1.75 acres, more or less, and being shown on plat book T at page 227, being a part of tract 3 on plat of J. W. Norwood, Jr., property in plat book J at page 225, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin the joint lines of lots 2 and 3 on the Norwood plat, approximately 525 feet east of the joint rear corner of lots 2 and 3, and running thence N 28-29 W, 292 feet to an iron pin; thence along the Layton property, 107 feet, more or less, to the center of a county road, known as the Layton Road; thence along the center of said road in a southerly and easterly direction 500 feet, more or less; thence S 2-21 W, 273 feet to an iron pin in the joint line of lots 2 and 3 on the Norwood plat; thence with said line, N 78-46 E, 391 feet to the point of beginning.
