WHEREAS, the said note has been paid in full and there is nothing due or owing on said note;

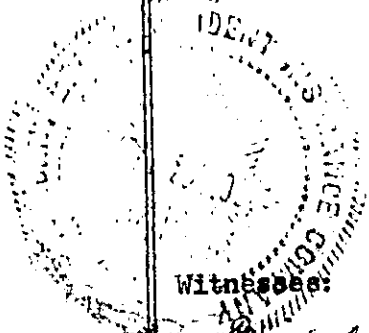

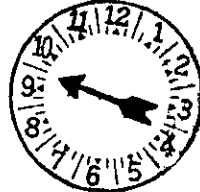
