(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by

these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said Marion E. Lanford and Sarah Ann McNeill, as Trustees, under Declaration of Trust, dated July 22, 1955, between Dr. M.L. Lanford, et al., as Donors, and Marion E. Lanford, et al, as Trustees, their Successors and Assigns Forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville,

County State of South Carolina, lying in or near the City of Greer, and north-west therefrom, and on the south side of a driveway which leads from Forest Street to the Needmore Colored Cemetery, bounded on the north by said driveway, on the east by lands now or formerly owned by Thomas C. Brooks, on the south by lands of Earl Dixon Duncan Estate, on the west by lands of said Estate and land now or formerly owned by T.E. Armstrong, having the following courses and distances according to a plat prepared by H.S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated September 18, 1945, as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING on an iron pin in the south side of driveway and on corner of T.E. Armstrong property, and runs thence S. 17-24 W. 318.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 72-31 E. 274.3 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot now or formerly belonging to Thomas C. Brooks; thence with that line, N. 17-31 E. 315.3 feet to an iron pin on the south side of driveway; thence with the south side of driveway, N. 72-00 W. 275 feet to the beginning corner, containing two acres, more or less.

The said Trust Agreement of July 22, 1955, confers upon the Trustees various powers including the power and authority:

To sell, resell, exchange, re-exchange, convey, reconvey, assign or otherwise transfer or dispose of any property, real or personal, at any time held by them as part of the Trust established hereinder, for cash, or other property, or upon credit, in such manner and upon such terms and conditions as they may deem best, and no person dealing with them shall be required to see to the application of any monies paid to them.

To borrow money and give security therefor.

To manage, operate, repair, rebuild, mortgage, rent and lease for such periods and upon such terms as they may deem best any real estate at any time held by them as Trustees hereunder.

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
